Since 25th March, only by appointment are performed: Inspections of the vehicles belonging to categories N2, N3, M2, M3, O3 and O4; the technical re-inspection of vehicles belonging to category N1, M1; all inspections of priority vehicles; the technical re-inspection of the agricultural vehicles. Starting on the next 20 April, only by appointment will be performed: the periodic inspections of passenger cars, camper vans and light commercial vehicles of which the inspection certificate expired before March 13, 2020; the periodic inspections of heavy commercial vehicles, buses, trailers, semi-trailers and agricultural vehicles; second-hand inspections; re-inspections; administrative inspections; inspections after accident, LPG and CNG inspections, homologation inspections and validation procedures. What is not yet performed is the periodic inspections of passenger cars, campers and light commercial vehicles with a green inspection certificate with an expiry date between March 13, 2020 and the end date of the emergency measures. The validation of the PTI certificate of these vehicles is extended by 4 months.
